Nepal is a landlocked country in South Asia. It is mainly situated in the Himalayas, but also includes parts of the Indo-Gangetic Plain, bordering the Tibet Autonomous Region of China to the north, and India in the south, east, and west, while it is narrowly separated from Bangladesh by the Siliguri Corridor, and from Bhutan by the Indian state of Sikkim.

The culture and tradition of Nepal is a culmination of its ethnicity, religions, values, and beliefs, tribal and social groups. Nepal's rich and diverse culture is reflected in its music, dance, art, literature, folklore and its language. It is a showcase of what the Nepalese lifestyle has to show and offer. Culture in Nepal is a symbol of the nation's wealthy, harmonized and diversified society.

Kathmandu is the nation's capital and the largest city. Kathmandu valley the City of Newars is described as "an enormous treasure house of art and sculptures", which are made of wood, stone, metal, and terracotta, and found in profusion in temples, shrines, stupas, gompas, chaityas and palaces. The art objects are also seen in street corners, lanes, private courtyards and in open ground. Most art is in the form of icons of gods and goddesses. Kathmandu valley has had this art treasure for a very long time.

Day 2: Nagarkot – Kathmandu – Pokhara (B/L/D)

After breakfast, drive to Pokhara by way of a scenic river valley. Enjoy boating on Phewa Lake the second largest lake of Nepal.

Day 3: Pokhara (B/L/D)

Wake up in the morning. Drive to Sarangkot (panoramic Himalayan views). After sunrise, back to hotel and have buffet Breakfast.

Day 4: Pokhara – Lumbini (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, drive to Lumbini. Visit the sacred location where Princess Maya Devi gave birth to Buddha.

Day 5: Lumbini – Kathmandu (B/L)

Experience the early morning alms rounds of the monks and prayer ceremonies before breakfast. Depart to Kathmandu.

Day 6: Kathmandu – Departure (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, visit to:

- Pashupatinath Temple
- Bouddhanath Stupa
- Swoyambhunath (Monkey Temple)
- Kathmandu Durbar Square

After tour, transfer to airport for flight home.
